This Deed of Sale made this 13th day of March
1879, between A. C. Norfleet of the first part and
W. C. Vaughan for the Farmers & Merchants Steam
Tram Company of the second part, Witness-
eth: that the party of the first part, in consideration
of the Sum of One Hundred & Sixty-Six & 66/100
dollars, it being the amount of his cash pay-
ment due for Stock in said Company, he agrees to
rent to the party of the second part, the Ware
House Wharf and a right of way to the street
now in use by the said Company for the term
of two years commencing March 20th 1880 and
ending March 20th 1882 and the party of the
first part retains the right to rent the wharf
to other parties, and the proceeds of which are
to be applied to his own use and he also retain-
ing the privilege of using the small end of the
Ware House for feed and obligates to keep
the wharf in repair. The said Company is
to have preference over all others, renting the wharf
& the party of the second part has a right to re-
