This Deed made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March in  
 the year 1879 between H. H. Norfleet and Nancy Scott  
 his wife of the County of Southampton and State  
 of Virginia of the first part and W. H. Jenkins Bro-  
 ther of the said County & State of the second part  
 Witnesses that for and in Consideration of the  
 sum of Five dollars to them in hand paid  
 by the said party of the second part the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they  
 the said parties of the first part do grant  
 bargain sell & convey with general warranty  
 unto the said W. H. Jenkins Trustee all of that  
 certain piece or parcel of land lying in the  
 County and State aforesaid the same on which  
 the said parties of the first part now reside  
 containing fifty (50) acres more or less and  
 bounded as follows on the north by the  
 lands known as the Parton Scott tract on  
 the South by the lands of J. P. Kitchin. On the  
 East by the lands of which the late John Scott  
 died seized & possessed and on the West by the  
 public road leading from Franklin to New Co.  
 Paralely's Store and the said parties of the  
 first part do further convey unto the said  
 Trustee all of their personal property consisting  
 of one horse one work or one Cart & Wagon  
 & all of their household & Kitchen furniture  
 consisting of beds chairs tables and other articles
