That for and in consideration of the sum of three
hundred and fifty Dollars in hand paid, the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do grant
begin, sell and convey unto the said Jno. H. Drake
all that portion of the land I bought of Harrison
D. Elmore Esq. lying on the Flagg run swamp beginning
at a Chopped Cypress in said swamp, where the County road
leading from Jerusalem to Franklin crosses said swamp
thence along the road leading to Cypress bridge to the
horse bone branch thence down the horse bone branch
along a line of Chopped trees to Flagg run swamp thence
up the said swamp to the beginning. Supposed to
contain Seventy acres be the same more or less.
The right and title to said land I warrant gener-
ally. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this 2nd day of April 1879.

and supposed to be Seventy acres be the same
more or less, and adjoining the lands of George

Dummon dec'd being the same land the said
J. H. Drake this day bought of Benj. E. Worrell
special reference is hereby made to that deed.
In trust to secure Benj. E. Worrell in a debt
due by bonds for three hundred and fifty dol-
lars, to be paid as follows (1/3) one third of said
debt to be paid Jan. 1st 1880, one other third to be
pd. Jan. 1st 1881, with interest from the 1st day of Jan
1880, and the other third to be pd. Jan. 1st 1882
with interest from the 1st day of Jan 1880, in
the event I fail to make the above payment
or any portion thereof, as they may fall due
the said Worrell reserves the right to sell
