Articles of Agreement between
Wm. G. Gay of said County and State, of the first part
and Jno W. Harrison of the same County and
State of the second part, to secure an adequate
sum according to act of the General
Assembly Entitld. "An Act to Secure ad-
vances for Agricultural purposes"

Whereas the said Wm. G. Gay being engaged in the
cultivation of the soil, and being without the nec-
essary means to cultivate his crop, Jno. W. Har-
rison has agreed to furnish goods and sup-
plies to the said Wm. G. Gay to an amount not to
exceed two hundred dollars, to enable him to
cultivate and harvest his crops for the year
1879. And in consideration thereof the said
Wm. G. Gay doth hereby give and conveys to the
said Jno. W. Harrison a lien upon his entire crop
of Cotton raised on the land of William Penn
which is cultivated by him the said Wm. G. Gay
The above to be null and void should the same
be found to be due on account of said advances
be discharged on or before the first day of Decem-
ber next. Otherwise the said Jno. W. Harrison
Executor, Administrators or assigns are hereby au-
thorized and empowered to seize the crop or any
part thereof which is raised by his Lien and
