This Deed made this 26th day of March in the
 year one thousand eight hundred and Seventy-nine
 Between Ellinrock et al. Clayton of the one part
 and C. T. Stephenson Trustee of the other part, Witness
 that the said party of the first part for and
 in consideration of the sum of one thousand
 (\$1000⁰⁰) Dollars, by the said party of the second
 part to the said party of the first part in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 Ellinrock et al. Clayton doth hereby grant and Convey
 unto the said C. T. Stephenson Trustee, all of the right
 title and interest of every kind whatsoever which
 the said Ellinrock et al. Clayton may have in and
 appertaining to the tract of land on which he now
 resides situated in the County of Southampton,^{state}
 of Virginia, estimated to contain three hundred
 and twenty six and three fourths acres (326 3/4 acres) to
 the same more or less and bounded as follows
 North by Seacock Swamp, East by the lands of
 A. T. Stephenson, South by the lands of Washington
 Edwards and wife, and on the west by the lands
 of William L. Stephenson also the following personal
 property to wit, One word Rob. one Bureau, six
 Chairs, Two Beds and furniture all of the said
 grantors Cooking utensils four head of cattle
 Twenty head of Hogs, one buggy & harness, two
 carts wheels, one Hog Kettle, Barn & garden together
 with all other chattel property of every kind
 whatsoever, now owned by the said Ellinrock et al.
 Clayton, which is now excepted by the last for
 the protection of poor debtors, all of which
 said Real and personal estate is hereby granted
 and Conveyed to the said C. T. Stephenson Trustee
 as aforesaid in Trust for the exclusive, se-
 parate and independent use & benefit of
 Emilie Clayton wife of the said Ellinrock et al.
 Clayton free and exempt from all claims and
 control of the said Mr. M. Clayton or his heirs
 for his debt, and it is expressly agreed by the
 grantors herein that the said Emilie Clayton
 shall have full power & authority to dispose
 of any or all of the said real or personally estate
 herein mentioned by her last will and testament.
