Boykin Carmichael & Co. v. Barham

The same as security for the payment of a line of Credit for the said Roscoe G. Barham with the firm of Boykin Carmichael & Co. in the city of Baltimore which said credit shall not be allowed to extend beyond the sum of One thousand five hundred dollars - and that power and authority is hereby given to the said Boykin Carmichael & Co. his heirs and assigns to foreclose this mortgage by sale of the premises whenever the said Barham shall allow his bills to extend past maturity for sixty days on twenty days notice posted at three or more public places in Southampton County in said State and personal service of same on said Barham, make title to purchaser or purchasers apply proceeds to indebtedness costs and expenses incident to the making executing and foreclosing this mortgage returning balance to Alice G. Barham or her representatives. In testimony whereof the said R. G. Barham and wife Alice G. Barham have hereunto affixed their hands & seals the 15th Feb. 1879.

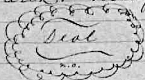
