to furnish said Ungherbark to an amount not
exceeding forty five dollars, Now therefore
the said Ungherbark hereby gives and grants a
lien to said J. B. Princes upon 2500 lbs
seed cotton or two bales cotton each to
weigh 425 lbs. and to be delivered at the
Store house of the said J. B. Princes by
the 1st day of December 1879 Witness the fol-
lowing signatures.

J. B. Princes upon all his crops cotton, corn &c.
or so much thereof as it will take to satisfy the
said debt. The manner to be paid for with 1/2 bale
cotton good, "missing" & to weigh each 425 lbs
