Prince, witnesses, that in as much as said George Sawyer is engaged in agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding seventy five dollars and also one ton Allison's fertilizer and whereas the said J. B. Prince are willing and have agreed to furnish said George Sawyer to an amount not exceeding seventy five dollars, and also one ton measure. Now therefore the said George Sawyer hereby gives and grants a lien to said J. B. Prince upon all his crops of Cotton grain & fodder or as much thereof as it will take to satisfy the said debt. The amount to be paid for with one bale Cotton goods "midling" & to weigh 450 lbs to be delivered at Bullfield by Nov. 1, 1879 and the said George Sawyer also gives a lien for said debt on one horse & two head witnesses the following signatures
