This agreement made this 5th day of April 1879
between Allen Reese and J. H. & J. B. Prince. Witnesses
that in as much as said Allen Reese is engaged
in Agriculture and desires advances and sup-
plies to an amount not exceeding Two hundred
fifty dollars and also one & half tons of
Nutrient Star Brand fertilizer and whereas
the said J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing and have
agreed to furnish said Allen Reese to an amount
not exceeding Two hundred & fifty dollars and
also one & half tons of the Star Brand manure,
now therefore the said Allen Reese hereby gives
and grants a lien to said J. H. & J. B. Prince upon
all his crop Cotton, corn & fodder or so much
thereof as it will take to satisfy the said debt.
The manner to be paid for with 1/2 bale cotton grade
"middling" & to weigh each 450 lbs to be delivered at
Beaufield by Nov. 1, 1879, and the said Allen Reese
also gives a lien for said debt on two mules.
