as Attorney for the said Joseph Bathwell, and
is therefore entitled to a Deed of Release;
Now this Deed witnesseth that in consideration
of the premises, the said Trustee doth hereby
release, acquit, claim and convey back to the
said Wm. J. McKinstry all such interest in said
real estate as was conveyed to the said Dr.
by the said McKinstry the same as if the said
Deed of Trust had never been executed.

of every kind whatsoever, in law or equity, in prop-
erty, expectancy or otherwise which they the said
parties of the first part or either of them, may have
or be entitled to, in and to the certain tract or
parcel of land situated in said County near
Baptist Depot and commonly known as Middlebrook.
