Pope trustee the following property to wit: One mule, flock of hogs, cattle, farming implements of every description, household and kitchen furniture, one double barrel gun all of my crops of corn, fodder cotton and pea-meats raised and gathered during the year 1879. In trust to secure Buy. E. Hornell and a debt due by bond for one hundred & forty six ⁷³/₁₀₀ Dollars - one bond due and on demand March 20th 78 for twenty six ⁷³/₁₀₀ Dollars, one other bond executed Jan. 1st 1879 due Dec. 25-1879 for Fifty Dollars.
