Knight the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Perry B. Fogg do grant and convey unto the said A. Knight all of her entire interest in and to Ellen Jane Carr's dower in the R. M. Town land which said Mrs. H. Pogg bought when sold and said land is bounded by the lands of H. Pope's heirs, L. H. Pope and others on the Barrow Road and said to contain one hundred and thirteen acres more or less and by this deed the said P. B. Fogg, warrants generally only all the title she is entitled to as she is only selling her entire interest in said land only, witnesses the following seals and signatures
