This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes. That whereas the said Cooper Turner Esq^r is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1879 from the said Jas. J. Sarder for the amount of Forty Dollars and for taking the acknowledgement and for recording this agreement, and the said Jas. J. Sarder having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies now the said Cooper Turner on his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a Lien to the said Jas. J. Sarder on one Bale of Cotton to weigh 450 Pounds to be made on the C. M. & St. Land on whence he lives for the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been expended and the said Turner binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said Cotton above mentioned to Jas. J. Sarder at Newson's
