This agreement entered into this 14th day of April 1879 between Jan. J. Darden R. D. Barham of the first part and Anthony Jones Esq. of the other part witnesses as follows: That whereas the said Anthony Jones Esq. is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1879 from the said Jan. J. Darden & R. D. Barham for the amount of twenty Dollars and for taking the acknowledgment and for recording this agreement, and the said Jan. J. Darden having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, Now the said Anthony Jones on his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth grant a Lien to the said Jan. J. Darden & R. D. Barham on his crops of all kinds to be made this year first to pay R. D. Barham twenty five Dollars and then enough to pay Jan. J. Darden forty five Dollars, for the amount advanced to him this year which has been on was intended himself expended, and the said Jones binds above mentioned to Jan. J.
