This Agreement entered into this the 20th day of March 1879 between H. M. Beaton and Walter Boone merchants and partners, trading under the firm name of H. M. Beaton & Co., of one part and Dennis Bryant of the other part, Witnesseth: That whereas the said Dennis Bryant is about to engage in the cultivation of the Soil and is desirous to obtain during the year 1879 advances in supplies from the said H. M. Beaton & Co. to the amount of One Hundred & Twenty Five Dollars beyond which limit the said Dennis Bryant shall not go; and the said H. M. Beaton & Co. having agreed, on their part to furnish the said advances, now the said Dennis Bryant on his part in consideration of the above premises, does hereby grant a lien to the said H. M. Beaton & Co. on the crops which may be raised during the year 1879 upon the lands in the cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 intituled "An Act to Secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes."
