and have agreed to furnish said Ridley  
to an amount not exceeding forty five dollars  
therefore the said Ridley hereby gives and  
grants a bill to said J. H. & J. B. Prince upon  
\$25.00 lbs seed Cotton or two bales Cotton each  
to weigh 4.25 lbs, and to be delivered at the  
store-house of the said J. H. & J. B. Prince by the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of December 1879. Witness the following signature
