 with general warranty, all his interest in his
 present stock of goods, wares & merchandises
 of every description except such as is exempt from
 levy, under which is known as "the poor debtor
 law". In trust to secure the following debts, a
 note due by J. R. Edwards to Commercial Bank
 of Suffolk, upon which A. W. Norfleet is Endorser
 dated 26 April 1879, and to secure all future receipts
 of said note, and a note due by A. W. Norfleet
 to James Vaughan for about \$300. exact amount
 and date not now remembered. And it is agreed
 by the parties hereto that in the event of a sale
 the trustee shall be entitled to five per cent on
 gross sales: and the sale shall be after 20 days
 public notice of time & place.
