For the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been expended and the said John Boone Hill binds himself agreeable to Law to deliver said Crops of Corn Cotton and Peanuts above mentioned to R. H. Blythe at Jerusalem or Franklin Va by or before December 20th 1879.

This Lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes
