Blythe binds himself agreeable to Law to deliver said Crop of Cotton, Corn & Peanuts above mentioned to R. H. Blythe at Franklin Va. or Jerusalem Va. by or before December 20th 1879. This Lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an act to secure the advances for Agricultural purposes. Witness the following signatures

This Agreement, made and entered into this 21st day of April 1879, between Pope & Gillette merchants of the first part and Moses Jones of the second, witnesses: That Whereas the said Moses Jones is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1879 from the said Pope & Gillette for the amount of Thirty Dollars, and the said Pope & Gillette having agreed to furnish said supplies and in consideration of the above advances and promises the said Moses Jones does hereby grant a lien to the said Pope & Gillette on all the crops which may be made during the year 1879 upon the land which the said Moses Jones does cultivate or has cultivated by tenants for the amount of above advances. And it is further agreed by the said parties to this agreement, that the crop and property above referred to is to be delivered to the said Pope & Gillette on or before the 1st day of December 1879.
