 resides. In consideration of said advances the
 said Jacob D. Daniels agrees to convey to
 said Niemeyer Etchings & Brooks all his crop
 made during said year, and that the said
 Niemeyer Etchings & Brooks shall have a
 lien for the full amount of such advances
 upon the whole of the crops raised by him
 during the year 1879, and also upon the person
 al property of the party of the second part
