In consideration of said advances the said Jacob Shugars agrees to consign to said Kiermeyer Eichenog & Brooks all his crops made during said year, and that the said Kiermeyer Eichenog & Brooks shall have a lien for the full amount of such advances upon the whole of the crops raised by him during the year 1879, and also upon all the personal property of the party of the second part of whatever kind.
