This agreement entered into this 24th day of May
1879 between R. H. Blythe of the first part and Tom
Horrell of the other part witnesseth as follows:
That whereas the said Tom Horrell is about
to engage in the cultivation of the soil and
is desirous to obtain supplies during the year
1879 from the said R. H. Blythe for the amount of
fifty (50) dollars and for taking the acknowledge-
ment and for recording this agreement, and said
R. H. Blythe having on his part agreed to furnish
said supplies. Now the said Tom Horrell on his
part and in consideration of the above premises
doth hereby grant a lien to said R. H. Blythe on
his crop of Corn, Cotton and Peanuts or a suffi-
cient amount thereof to pay the above amount
in full, which crop he binds himself to deliver
to said R. H. Blythe of Jerusalem or at Franklin
No. by or before the first day of December 1879
namely the crop made on the farm of Alexander Stev-
ens, this year where the said Tom Horrell now lives
for the amount advanced to him this year, which
has been or was intended to have been expended.
But the said Tom Horrell binds himself agreeable
to law to deliver said crop of Corn, Cotton and
Peanuts also mentioned to R. H. Blythe at Jeru-
salem or Franklin No. by or before the 1st day
of December 1879. This lien is granted under an
Act of the General Assembly of Virginia appro-
ved April 2, 1872, entitled an act to use the advances for ag-
