Prince the following property to wit: Four 10 horses & mules, namely 3 Black mules called Dick, Patsy & Jim, 1 mares color mule called Charley & one Bay mare mule called Dick, 1 Bay mare mule called Julia, & one large Black mare mule called Molly, also 1 sorrel horse called Dexter, one Bay mare called Pidgeon & one Bay mare 5 years old called Belle, also 4 yoke of Oxen
