

Know all men by these Presents, that I, S. B. Alley
of the County of Southampton and State of Vir-
ginia in consideration of the sum of Four-
teen hundred & sixty-eight ²⁹/₁₀₀ Dollars, to me
in hand paid by David C. Lassiter and John
Brockwell, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledge, have granted bargained and sold
and by these presents do grant bargain and
sell unto the said Lassiter and Brockwell
the following articles of personal property
that is to say: One Steam Saw mill and
fixtures - being the same sold as the prop-
erty of J. C. Randolph by W. W. Briggs Sheriff
for miles. one Bay horse, five ⁵/₁₆ of
harness. one log wagon and chains two
bugies with chains &c. To have and to
hold, all and singular the said goods
and chattels unto the said Lassiter and
Brockwell, and their executors, admin-
istrators and assigns; to his and their
use forever. And I, the said S. B. Alley for
myself and for my executors and ad-
ministrators, do covenant to and with
the said D. C. Lassiter and John B.
Brockwell, and with their executors, ad-
ministrators and assigns that I am
lawfully possessed of the said goods
and chattels as of my own property
that the same are free from all
incumbrances, and that I will and
my executors and administrators
shall warrant and defend the same
to the said Lassiter & Brockwell, their
executors, administrators and assigns against
the lawful claims and demands of all per-
sons, provided nevertheless that if the said
S. B. Alley, his executors or administrators
shall will and truly pay unto the said
Lassiter and Brockwell, their executors, admin-
istrators or assigns the sum of Fourteen
Hundred and Sixty-eight ²⁹/₁₀₀ Dollars, one
dollar with interest at nine (9) per. cent.
then this debt, as also a note bearing date
of the 19th day of December 1878, signed by
S. B. Alley and endorsed by Crawford Allyn
for the sum of Eight Hundred & Sixty-eight
²⁹/₁₀₀ Dollars, and payable on demand and
a note bearing date of May 24th 1879 signed
by S. B. Alley for the sum of Six Hundred -
