I know all men by their presents that
 I John E. Applewhite of the County and
 State aforesaid for and in consideration
 of the sum of Sixty dollars to me in hand
 paid by Jas. E. Sebock the receipt of which
 is hereby acknowledged, have by these pres-
 ents granted unto J. E. Sebock Two Bales
 of Cotton to be made on my farm this
 year (1879) and also the increase of a
 second crop bought this year, the above
 Cotton to be delivered to said Sebock on
 or before the 15th December 1879. I also grant
 unto H. M. Beaton Co. of Boykins Depot Va.
 all the balance of my crops to be made
 this year and all interest that I may have
 in any crop on my farm for the sum
 of Two Hundred dollars advanced or is
 to be advanced to me this year by said
 Beaton Co. all the said crops, after deliv-
 ering to J. E. Sebock, the two first bales
 Cotton to be delivered to H. M. Beaton Co.
 by or before the 15th Dec. 1879. Witness my
 hand & seal this 4th day of June 1879.
