as Trustee of the second part. Witnesseth that
the said John H. Drake doth grant and convey
unto the said K. R. Griffin the following per-
sonal property to wit: his the said J. H. Drake's
entire crops of Cotton, corn and peanuts
raised on his farm on which he resides in
the County of Southampton, consisting of Ten
acres in Cotton, Twenty acres in Corn, Ten
acres in peanuts; said Cotton, corn and
peanuts or so much of them as may be
necessary, to be delivered at the store of W.
H. Jenkins Co in Franklin on or before the
1st day of November 1879, and in default of
such delivery the Trustee aforesaid shall
have the right to advertise said crops and
sell them on the premises of said Drake
