

said crops at the aforesaid place of purchase of said Jenkins 10th as rapidly as they can be made ready for market at any time before the 1st day of November and should the said Drake fail to make such delivery then the said Griffin shall have the above mentioned right to sell on the premises and the said Drake in addition to the above mentioned crops, grants and conveys unto the said Griffin trustee of and said the following personal property to wit: Three work Horses, Four Cattle, Grains & three Colves, all of which is conveyed in trust to secure the following debts to wit: One note dated Feb 1st 1879 due and payable on demand by the said Drake of forty three dollars and fifty six cents and payable unto Joel H. Cushman or order and secondly one note dated March 29, 1879 and payable Nov: 1st 1879 to W. H. Jenkins 10th of one hundred & fifty dollars, and in default of payment of either one of the said notes, the trustee shall sell any of the said property conveyed in the instrument and pay the same from the proceeds of such sale.
