This agreement entered into this 14th June 1879,
between Jas. J. Darden of the first part and
Smith Bynum coed. of the other part. Witness
it as follows. That whereas the said Smith
Bynum coed. is about to engage in the
cultivation of the soil, and is desirous
to obtain supplies during the year 1879 from
the said Jas. J. Darden for the amount of
Thirty five Barrels and for taking the ac-
knowledgment and for recording this agree-
ment and the said Jas. J. Darden having on his
part agreed to furnish said supplies, & that
the said Smith Bynum on his part and
in consideration of the above provisions do
hereby grant a Lien to the said Jas. J. Darden
on One Bale of middling Cotton to weigh
450 lbs or over to be made the year 1879
and I hereby waived the benefit of my
Homestead exemption as to this Debt
or Contract. For the amount advanced to
him this year which has been or was inten-
ded to have been expended, and the said
Bynum binds himself agreeable to law to de-
liver said Cotton above mentioned to Jas.
Darden at Newsums Depot Va. by or before
the 1st day of Novr 1879. This Lien is granted
under an Act of the General Assembly of
Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an
act to secure the advances for agricultural
