This agreement entered into this 16th day of June
1879 between R. H. Blythe of the first part and Robert
Crocker of the said part witnesses as follows that
whereas the said Robert Crocker has engaged in
the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain
supplies from the said R. H. Blythe for the amount
of thirty five dollars and for taking the ac-
knowledgment and for recording this agreement and
the said R. H. Blythe having agreed on his part to
furnish said supplies, that the said Robert Crocker
on his part and in consideration of the above
agreement doth hereby grant a lien to said
R. H. Blythe on the whole of his crop of corn
cotton and peanuts or sufficient thereof to
pay the above amount in full, which crop he
binds himself to deliver to the said R. H. Blythe
at Jerusalem or at Franklin Va. by or before the
first day of December 1879, that being the crop made on
the land owned by himself in the County of Southamp-
ton Va. this year where the said Robt Crocker now
lives for the amount advanced to him this year, which
has been or was intended to have been expended.
And the said Robt Crocker binds himself to deliver to
the said R. H. Blythe at Jerusalem or at Franklin Va. by or before the first day of
December 1879. This lien is granted under an act
