Grand This Deed made this 1st day of June in the year
 1879 between Thomas W. Oliver of the 1st part & Samuel
 B. Putton of the 2nd part all of the County of
 Southampton & State of Virginia. Witnesseth:
 that the said Thomas W. Oliver doth grant
 unto the said Samuel B. Putton the fol-
 lowing property to wit: all of his crop of
 Peanuts & Cotton to be made during the
 year 1879 in the County of Southampton, in trust
 to secure a certain Bond held by John Put-
 ton Jr: & executed by the said Thomas W. Oliver
 to the said John Putton Jr: for the sum of
 One Hundred & twenty five \$/s dollars bearing
 date June 1st 1879, but due November 1st 1879.
 And it is covenanted between the parties, that in
 the event of the death of said Thomas W.
 Oliver before the selling of said crops here
