from the said Darden & Mclynch for the  
sum of Seventy Dollars and for taking  
the acknowledgement and recording the ag-  
reement and the said Darden & Mclynch having  
on their part agreed to furnish said sup-  
plies to the said Jack Bryant on his  
part, and in consideration of the above  
provisions doth hereby grant a lien to  
the said Darden & Mclynch on all the  
Crops of Cotton, Corn, Tobacco, Peas and  
Peanuts, that may be raised by the said
