Vaughan, containing by estimation two hundred acres more or less, it being the land bought by the said Joyner and conveyed to him by deed of Bryant & Sale dated the 9th day of July 1879 from Edith L. Vaughan, M. J. Vaughan and others, in trust to secure the following debt to wit: one bond bearing date the 12th day of July 1879, and payable with interest from date three years, after date for Five Hundred, three & ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars (\$503.⁰⁰/₁₀₀), unto James Vaughan or order, also three bonds bearing same date with this date payable without interest, one, two & three years after date respectively, for fifteen, thirty, and thirty five dollars each, and payable unto the said James Vaughan or order, and if the said Joyner shall make default in payment of any one of said bonds, when due then the said trustee shall on receiving notice from said Vaughan, advertise said land, and sell the same for cash, and after deducting all legal expenses from the proceeds of sale of said land, together with five per centum on said proceeds unto the said trustee together with the amount of said bonds (or if they would have fallen due the day of sale) which amount shall be paid unto said Vaughan etc. said trustee shall pay the remainder of said sale unto the said Joyner or order Witness the following signature and seal.
