This Indenture made and entered into on
 the 24th day of August in the year of our Lord
 1896, between J. D. Putlow and Mary J. D. Putlow
 wife Mary H. Putlow, Sarah S. Putlow, John
 C. Putlow and Sarah B. Putlow and Mary
 H. Putlow of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia of the first part,
 and Osevin White of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia of the second part,
 Witnesseth that the said parties of the
 first part for and in consideration of
 the sum of two hundred dollars to us
 in hand paid by the said Osevin White
 the receipt of which was so hereby acknow-
 ledged, both bargained, sold, conveyed
 and by these presents doth bargain, sell
 & convey unto the said Osevin White his
 heirs & assigns a lot of land in the Village
 of Franklin fronting on Clay St. located as
 follows, beginning at a point on the west
 side of Clay St. eleven hundred & fifty five
 feet 10 inches (1155 ft. 10 in) & fifty nine & a quarter
 degrees East (39 1/4° E.) from the junction of the
 west side of Clay St. with the Corporation line
 at Deamons Corner, thence along Clay St. one
 hundred & forty five feet two inches (145 ft. 2 in)
 S 89 1/4° E. thence 300 ft. S. 30 1/4° west thence 145 ft. S
 89 1/4° west, thence 300 ft. N 30 1/4° E. along
 street to place of beginning, together with
 all the privileges & appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing or in any wise appurtening unto him the
 said Osevin White his heirs and assigns forever.
 Now know ye the said parties of the first part
 doth Covenant & agree to and with the said
 party of the second part that after the delivery
 of these presents to warrant and secure the
 right & title of the aforesaid lot of land unto
 the said Osevin White his heirs and assigns
 against the claim of any and all manner
 of persons to all intents and purposes, what-
