This Deed made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1878  
between Jacob Lewis and Louisa J. his wife, grantor  
of the County of Northampton State of Virginia  
of the first part, and Leetton R. Edwards of the  
same County and State, chosen as Trustee of  
the second part, witnesseth that the said Jacob  
Lewis and Louisa J. his wife grantors aforesaid  
do grant with general warranty unto the said  
Leetton R. Edwards, trustee, in order to secure  
the payment of one bond and due and due unto  
Jethro Cobb for the purchase money for the  
real property to be hereinafter described unto  
the certain lot or parcel of land lying in the  
Town of Franklin and bounded as follows:  
commencing at the west east intersection of  
4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and High Street, thence in a  
southerly direction along the eastern boundary  
of High Street, two hundred and ten feet  
to Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Avenue, thence in an easterly  
direction along the northern boundary of  
3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, one hundred and five (105)  
feet; thence in a northerly direction, along  
a parallel with the High Street boundary  
two hundred and ten (210) feet to the south  
ern boundary of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, thence in a  
western direction along the southern boundary  
of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue one hundred and five (105)  
feet to the point of beginning, it being the lot
