This Agreement made this first day of June in the year 1879. between John W. Saunders of the first part and John I. Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said John W. Saunders is engaged in, and about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said John I. Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil which the said John W. Saunders has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth; That the said John I. Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said John W. Saunders during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of \$100.00 or hundred dollars in amount) as may be needed to enable the said John W. Saunders to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said John W. Saunders hereby gives and grants to the said John I. Turner
