Worrell shall not go, and the said Robert T. Andrews having agreed on his part to furnish the said advances, Now the said Edw. ^{Worrell} on his part in consideration of the above promises does hereby grant a lien to the said Robert T. Andrews on the crops which may be made by him during the year 1879, upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873 entitled, "An Act to Secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes".
