Darden or one Bale of middling Cotton to weigh 450 lbs for the above aforesaid being for Cotton to be made this year, and I hereby waive the benefit of my Homestead Exemption as to this debt on condition for the amount advanced to him this year, which he b
ew or was intended to have been expended, and the said Gursley binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said Cotton above mentioned to Jas. J. Darden at Newsome's Depot No. 6 by or before the 1st day of Decr. 1879. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes.
