 to a Sourswood, on Washington Holland thence N 47<sup>o</sup> 24'  
 77 links to a red oak in said Hollands line, thence  
 N 10<sup>o</sup> 2' West 3.60 chains to a post, thence N 85<sup>o</sup> 2' W 7.5 links  
 to the first station, containing one and fifty seven (157<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>)  
 hundredth acres, which land and premises the  
 said Allen H. Cotton and Almira his wife for and  
 in consideration of the sum of Five dollars, to  
 them in hand paid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) do hereby convey to Daniel Bradshaw, Augustus

 in office ad infinitum; together with all their  
 right, title and interest in the premises and  
 appurtenances thereon situated. In witness

 the facts herein stated, have hereunto set their
