This Agreement made and entered into the 5th day of March 1879 between *J. E. Bailey* of the first part and *Ann Simmons* of the second part. Witnesseth as follows that whereas the said *Simmons* is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies Fertilizers &c during the year 1879 from the said *J. E. Bailey* for the amount of one hundred dollars. And the said *Bailey* having agreed to furnish the said supplies now the said *Simmons* on her part & in consideration of the above advances and promises does hereby grant unto the said *J. E. Bailey* a Lien on all the crops that may be made during the year 1879 upon the lands that the said *Simmons* cultivates for the amount of the above advance & cost of this agreement. It is further more agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said *J. E. Bailey* on or before the first day of Dec. 1879 and that no part of said crops shall be sold unless it is by and through the said *Bailey* until this agreement is satisfied.
