Witnesseth as follows that whereas the said Blom is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies, Fertilizers &c. during the year 1879 from the said Bailey for the amount of Fifty Dollars, And the said Bailey having agreed to furnish the said supplies now the said Blom on his part and in consideration of the above advances and promises does hereby grant unto the said Bailey a lien on all the crops that may be made during the year 1879 upon the lands that the said Blom cultivates for the amount of the above advance cost of this agreement. It is further more agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to said Bailey on or before the first day of Decr. 1879 and no part of said crops shall be sold unless it is by and through the said Bailey until this agreement is satisfied.
