Seaborn during the year 1879, to the amount of, and not exceeding the sum of sixty five dollars, he the said Jos. Seaborn in accordance with section 12 Chapter CXV code of Virginia 1873, hereby gives and constitutes this a special lien on the entire crops of every kind and description to be grown on his farm in said County, during said year (1879) to secure to D. J. Garratt, and his heirs or assigns, the sum of sixty five dollars, advanced as aforesaid, which he, the said Jos. Seaborn owes and promises to pay on demand, the 1st day of November 1879, and hereby waives the benefit of Homestead Exemption for the payments thereof. As a further security for the payment of the aforesaid sum of sixty five dollars, and in consideration of five dollars in hand paid, to the said Jos. Seaborn hereby bargained and sold unto D. J. Garratt the following property: One ~~Wagon~~, one cow & two yearlings Farming utensils &c. to be delivered to him on his order on the 1st day of November 1879, or when ever thereafter demanded, until which time I retain the possession of said property as a loan from said Garratt.
