 dated February 1st 1879, for the sum of forty three
 $\frac{3}{10}$ dollars and the other dated April 1st
 1879, for the sum of forty three $\frac{4}{10}$ dollars, said
 notes being due for supplies in money and
 goods furnished me for the purpose of pay-
 ing for labour for getting lumber and for
 Farming purposes and being desirous to pay
 the same, I therefor make this a Bill of Sale
 to the said R. H. Blythe for all of my growing
 crop of Corn, Cotton, Peanuts and for all
 else of my personal property of every kind, con-
 sisting of Household and Kitchen furniture
 all Farming implements and all of my
 Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Horses, all of which
 property I bind myself to deliver to the said
 R. H. Blythe on sufficient of the same to pay the
 above amount of eighty six $\frac{7}{10}$ dollars, with
 interest in full when called for. Witness my

 1879 between Benjamin C. Drew and Emily his
 wife of the one part and L. F. Bain of the other
 part - Witnesseth that the said Benjamin C. Drew
 and Emily A. his wife doth grant unto the said
 L. F. Bain the following real estate viz:- the
 land tract of 1006 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land in Southampton
 County, in trust to secure a bond for twelve
 hundred and fifty Dollars held against the said Benjamin
 C. Drew by Mr. T. Holt dated 2nd day of July
 1879. Now if the said Benjamin C. Drew shall
 pay the aforesaid bond and interest thereon, to
 this deed is to be void, otherwise it shall
 be lawful for the said L. F. Bain to advertise
 and sell to the highest bidder for each
 the above named real estate and first
