This deed made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of December  
in the year 1878, between Wm. W. Moore of the one  
part and E. L. Story of the other part, witnesseth  
that the said Wm. W. Moore doth grant unto  
the said E. L. Story the following property. One  
lot in the town of Franklin containing one  
hundred fourteenth of an acre more or less, with all  
the buildings and appurtenances thereunto be-  
longing, lying between Third and Fourth Avenues  
and the same bounded one side by the lot of Anthony
