Received this deed made this the 22nd day of February
 in the year 1879 - between Edward Beaton of the
 first part and Wesley Mason, Simon Pitt &
 Joshua Pitt Trustee for the Church of the
 other part. Witnesseth, that for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Thirty dollars, to him
 in hand paid, the said party of the first part
 doth grant unto the said parties of the second
 part, a certain lot, piece and parcel of land
 situated in Southampton County, State of Virgin-
 ia, and lying on the County road leading from
 Branchville to Creek Kyne, this lot contains one
 acre, commencing at the County road going
 south to a white oak fence west to a Pew-
 chine tree to the County road. The said per-
 sons of the second part for themselves, their
 executors, administrators and assigns hereby
 covenant that they will never use the said
 lot, piece and parcel of land for any other
 purpose whatsoever, other than for the erec-
 tion of a Colored Baptist Church, and to
 be used as such - and the party of the first
 part hereby reserves the right to re-enter
 and take possession of said lot, piece and
 parcel of land and forfeiture of covenant
 witness my hand and seal the
