This deed made this the 22nd day of February in the year 1879, between Edward Beeson of the first part and Wiley Mason, Simon Peter & Joshua Britt Trustees for the Church of the latter part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars, to him in hand paid, the said party of the first part doth grant unto the said parties of the second part, a certain lot, piece and parcel of land situated in Southampton County, State of Virginia, and lying on the County road leading from Branchville to Croft Kygo, this lot contains one acre, commencing at the County road going South to a white oak thence west to a Pine thence back to the County road. The said parties of the second part for themselves, their heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, hereby covenant that they will never use the said lot, piece and parcel of land for any other purpose whatsoever, other than for the erection of a Colored Baptist Church, and to be used as such, and the party of the first part hereby reserves the right to re-enter and take possession of said lot, piece and parcel of land and forfeiture of Covenant.
