THIS DEED, made this first day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred seventy nine between George W. Harris and Martha Ann his wife of the first part, and Franklin Vick of the second party, Witnesseth that, in consideration of the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, the said George W. Harris and Martha Ann his wife do grant unto the said Franklin Vick with General Warranty, all of their right title and interest in a certain piece or parcel of land containing nine acres more or less, it being the same piece of land as bought of W. H. Morris, and known as a portion of the George D. Davis tract, said piece or parcel of land was deeded by W. H. Morris to Martha Ann Harris and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, by the said W. H. Morris wife and bounded as follows: Commencing at post oak on the Wakefield road running a westerly direction to a pine inside of Geo. D. Davis field, thence south to the Littleton road, thence up said road to the Wakefield road, thence down said Wakefield road to the beginning, all buildings and appurtenances on said land to go to the said Franklin Vick. The said George W. Harris and Martha Ann his wife covenants that they have the right to convey the said land to the grantees; that they have done no act to encumber the said land; that the grantees shall have
