This Deed, made this 5th day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and nine between James Lawrence Morris and Rosa B. Morris his wife of the one part, and Benjamin Brister (Trustee) of the other part -
Witnesseth, that the said James Lawrence Morris and Rosa B. Morris his wife do grant unto the said Benjamin Brister (Trustee) the following property to wit: one certain piece or parcel of Land, it being the same as deeded the day to the said James Lawrence Morris by Franklin Vickre and E. Josephine his wife, and known as a portion of the Benjamin Brister tract. Containing one hundred and six acres more or less and bounded as follows, on the north by B. St. Travis, on the South by Polly Onay, on the East by a line of marked trees commencing at a dead oak on Polly Onay's line and running in north east direction to a red oak on Mrs. Eliza Wellens line, on its west by its lands belonging to the Estates of Colundra Herter deceased.
