This agreement made and entered into this the 17th day of April A.D. 1879 between William Jordan of the first part and Elias R. Vick of the second part, Witnesseth as follows: That whereas William Jordan is engaged in farming on the land belonging to the said Elias R. Vick and whereas the said William Jordan has already obtained some supplies from the said Vick to enable him to carry on his farming operations on the said land, and is desirous of obtaining more in all not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars, Now I the said William Jordan do by these presents grant a lien to the said Elias R. Vick on all the crops raised on the said land to secure the said Vick for the supplies which have been or may hereafter be furnished and it is specially agreed that none of said crops raised this year shall be moved from the said land without the consent of the said Vick until the amount which says
