Powell, his executors, administrators or assigns shall prescribe and administer in case of his failure to give such direction at such time and in such manner as the said Trustee shall think fit. The said Mills J. Powell covenants to pay all taxes, assessments, dues and charges upon the property hereby conveyed so long as he or his heirs or assigns shall hold the same.

This Deed made the 16th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seventy nine between M. E. Daughtry and Ellen V. his wife of the first part and W. L. Shaver trustee of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witness as follows:
Whereas the Circuit Court of said County did at the May term 1879 direct in the
