

This deed of Trust made this 15th day of Sept. A. D. 1879
 between Wm. H. Grant of the first part, Rufus E. Darden Trustee
 & Co. of the second part, and Darden & Myrick of the third part
 witnesseth as follows, that the said Wm. H. Grant doth grant
 unto the said Rufus E. Darden Trustee with general war-
 ranty the following property: To wit, All of my entire interest
 in the crops cultivated by the said Grant on the Cook-
 Farm consisting of Corn, Fodder, Peas, Pea Nuts and Cotton
 In trust however to secure the following debt due Darden
 & Myrick. One Bond for Two Hundred and Seventy Dollars
 dated Sept. 15th 79 with interest from Jan'y 1st 80.
 It is hereby covenanted and agreed between the parties
 to this deed that no sale shall take place under this deed
 without the consent of the said Wm. H. Grant prior to the
 1st day of December 1879, and that when a sale does take
 place, should one be necessary, it shall be for cash after
 giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale, the
 proceeds after paying the cost and expenses of this trust
 shall be applied to the payment of the aforesaid Bond
 due the said Darden & Myrick. The balance if any pay
 over to the said Wm. H. Grant or his legal representative.
